

PROJECT SUMMARY

The David Strangway building is located on University Boulevard which is the primary entranceway into UBC. Important landmarks in the immediate area will include the UBC Transit Exchange, War Gym Memorial, UBC Aquatic Centre, MacInnes Sports Field, Robert H. Lee Alumni Centre, UBC Life Building, and AMS Student Nest.

- UBC is ranked the #2 University in Canada.
- A global centre for research and teaching with student enrollment of more than 60,863, with 28% of those being international students (2024).
- The daytime population at UBC is 80,000 people.

- University Boulevard is the primary bike corridor on campus.
- 156,000 daily trips to and from UBC (transit, vehicular, bike) with over half of the trips on transit.
- Wesbrook Mall/University Boulevard intersection sees 10,000 vehicles and 1,000 bikes daily (weekday).






FLOOR PLAN



FLOOR PLAN


